



Isis 920i Sports Cruiser

The design of the ISIS 920i is down to Naval Architect Trevor Whittaker from Queens University. He has juggled the attributes of quite a deep-vee forebody, to help ensure comfort in a head sea, with fairly efficient aft sections, which at the centre line flattens out almost completely.

A shallow keel has also been incorporated to help with slow speed work. With the single engine the drivetrain makes use of this. The waterline has been kept as long as possible, given the boats length of 30'. The bathing platform is fully integrated into the hull. An attractive whaleback shape to the deck sheer means that forward headroom inside the accommodation is maximised without an over-obtrusive coachroof which blends into the overall design shape.

Every square inch of the interior is put to good use. The saloon, which incorporates the Helm to starboard, is a good size with plenty of sociable seating. It is airy inside, thanks to the two sliding sunroofs in the deckhead. Much of the Saloons roominess is due to the fact that the Galley, which is a useful size and well appointed, is tucked down at a lower level rather than a sideboard as tends to be the norm is this size of boat. Even so, there is still room for usable sized cabins with good-size berths, and they are both en-suite, as they each have their own access to the toilet compartment, no matter who turns in early or is up with the lark, this arrangement ensures that modesty prevails. This applies even if guests are sleeping in the 3 Berth Saloon, as the WC has a third entrance door for daytime use.

The fit-out is achieved partly by use of mouldings and American Cherry joinery. The fully integrated Bathing Platform allows easy boarding, with the coamings and the door through to the Cockpit being a good height and topped with handrails. There are plenty of storage lockers and access to the Bilge area in the Cockpit. The Lazarette gives access to the Bilge installation and the rear of the Engine. The entire Bilge area is moulded out giving a high quality look to this area. A Sunbrella Canopy is available. With 7 Berths and loads of storage space the ISIS 920i is probably the most cleverly designed 30 footer on the market today with performance and looks to match.
